**INCLUDE PROVISIONS FOR
SUBSEQUENT EFFECTS-BASED
UNDERTAKINGS**

**PREPARE SEPARATE
PROTOCOLS WITH
DIFFERENTIATED OBLIGATIONS
ON EMISSION REDUCTION**

**CONSIDER BASE YEARS AND
TARGET YEARS FOR
IMPLEMENTATION OF
OBLIGATIONS AND
COMPLIANCE MONITORING**
